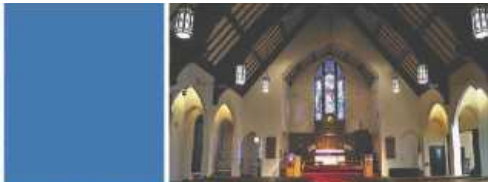
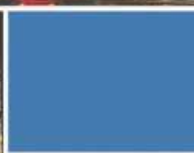

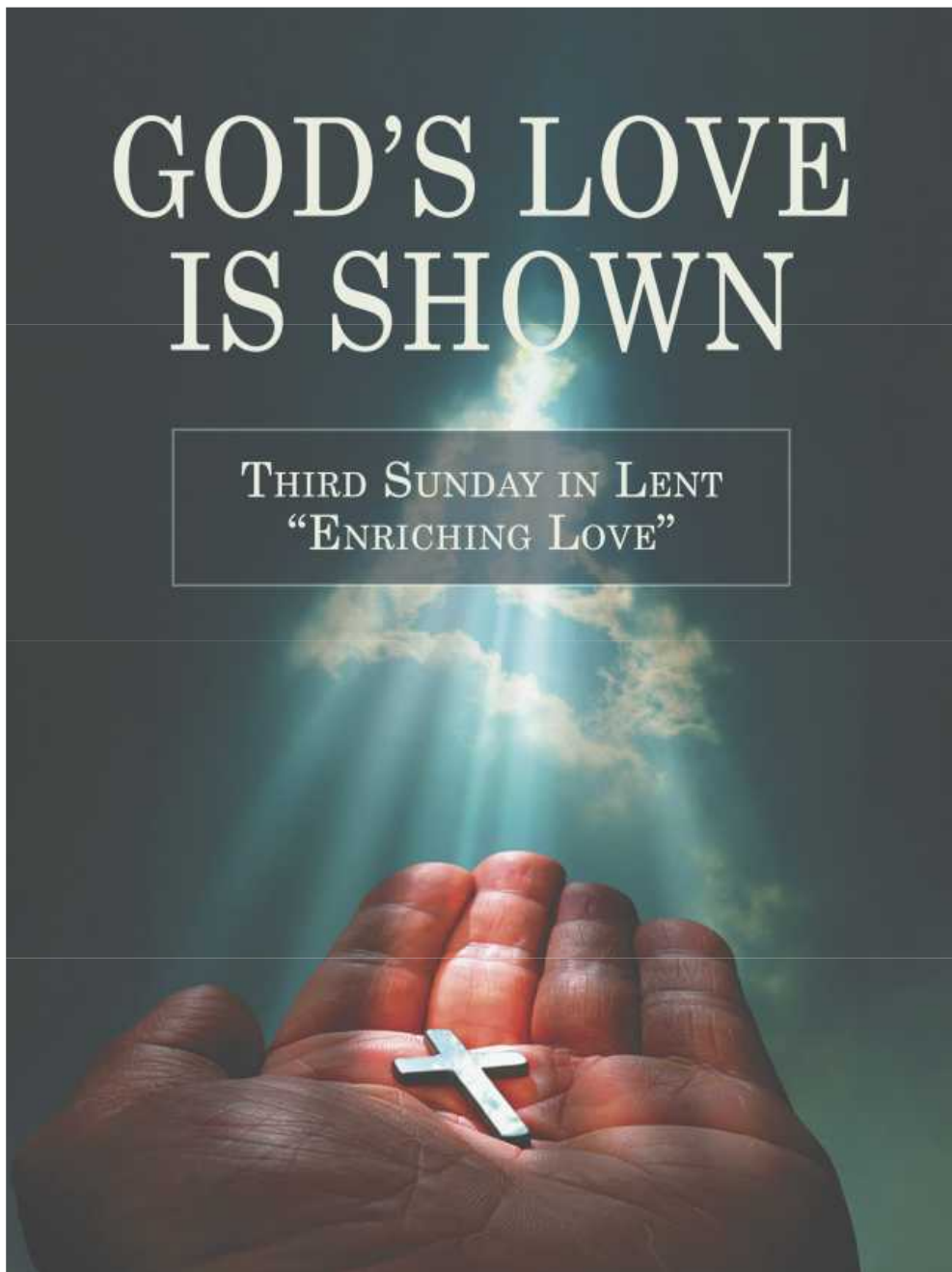

¹Paul, called by the will of God to be an apostle of Christ Jesus, and our brother Sosthenes, ²To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours: ³Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. ⁴I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, ⁵ that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge— ⁶ even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you— ⁷ so that you are not lacking in any spiritual gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁸who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

LENTEN WORSHIP SERIES

"God's Love Is Shown" Week 3: "Enriching Love"

In our service this weekend we will look at the enriching nature of the love our Lord has for us. His love fills us with good things and helps us to grow and develop into the people he wants us to be. In this, God's love is shown.

MIDWEEK LENTEN ONLINE STUDY

In the Gospel according to Mark, he devotes one-third of his writing to the last week of Jesus' life. During those seven days we call Holy Week, we hear different cries from different people. This year in Lent we are exploring those different cries. These "Cries of the Passion" will be presented in a Bible Study format, with hymns, and prayers interspersed throughout. Instead of in-person worship services, these studies will be offered on Wednesdays at 3:30 PM on our social platforms, or on WTCH radio at 6:30 PM. By spending some devoted time and study in this week of Jesus' life, we will be better prepared to celebrate the life-saving events of Holy Week and Easter.
