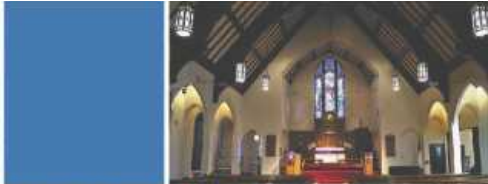

### SERMON TEXT: LUKE 2:39-52

<sup>40</sup>And the child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom. And the favor of God was upon him.
