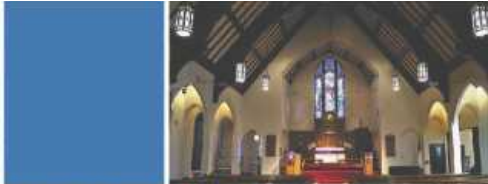
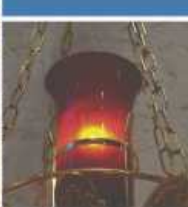

BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST JESUS,

Here is the latest concerning the Coronavirus and our life together at St. James. We continue to pray the words of the Psalmist:

“God is our Refuge and Strength, an ever-present help in all our troubles, therefore we will not fear” – Psalm 46

Now, as we place our trust in our Refuge and Strength, what are we doing at St. James in response to the Coronavirus? Please consider the following:

- Due to the CDC’s recent guidance on large events and the order prohibiting mass gatherings of 10 people or more from Governor Evers and the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, all on-site activities and worship are canceled until further notice.
- The health and safety of our congregation and community is our top priority. We do not want to further the spread of COVID-19 by hosting services, classes, or any gatherings until we have received further guidelines.
- We are working on a plan to have the Wednesday Lenten Services and weekend services put on Facebook and our website and also recorded for broadcast on the radio.
- Broadcast times are the same on WTCH 96.1FM/ WTCH 960AM Wednesdays at 6:30 PM and Sundays at 9:00 AM
- As you are able, please continue to excel in the grace of giving. Utilize the option of giving online or mail your offerings to the office (324 S. Andrews St) so we can continue to minister and be ready to

hit the ground ready post-COVID 19 crisis.

- We are encouraging people to follow the guidelines and study the information posted by the Center for Disease Control on the government website rather than follow rumor and hearsay. Please take advantage of the accurate, up to date information provided at: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html> and respond accordingly.
- Join us in praying for those whose lives have been directly impacted by the virus.
- Check the church website and/or Facebook page for updates regarding scheduling of specific events.

Be assured that we are constantly monitoring the situation and will make announcements as these become necessary.

Scripture Readings:

SCRIPTURE OF THE DAY

1 CORINTHIANS 12:12-27

¹²For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. ¹³For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

¹⁴For the body does not consist of one member but of many. ¹⁵If the foot should say, “Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body,” that would not make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁶And if the ear should say, “Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,” that would not make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁷If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell? ¹⁸But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. ¹⁹If

all were a single member, where would the body be?

²⁰As it is, there are many parts, yet one body.

²¹The eye cannot say to the hand, “I have no need of you,” nor again the head to the feet, “I have no need of you.” ²²On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, ²³and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, ²⁴which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it, ²⁵that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. ²⁶If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together. ²⁷Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.
